Emergency Preparedness Month

Thank you to the **Delta Firefighters** for visiting some of our Primary classes to discuss **Fire Safety & Awareness**. Students were asked to discuss a 'family safety' plan at home.

Driving to School?

IB PYP: Essential Agreements

In a PYP school, each working group (teachers or students) starts off by creating an 'essential agreement'. In the classroom, this means that rather than teachers imposing rules for the class, the students and teachers work collaboratively to decide what is important for their class community to run smoothly. By constructing these agreements together, students take more ownership in following them. The class will refer to these agreements on a regular basis, both to remind students what they agreed was important, as well as to reflect on whether they are still functioning well for the group. Ask your child what some of the essential agreements are in their classroom!
