



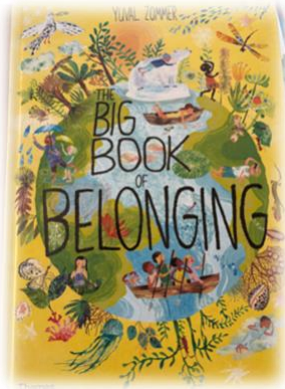

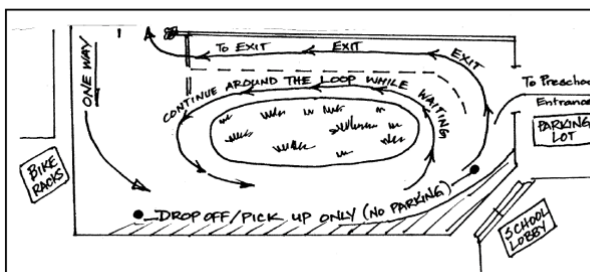

Driving to School?
