## PAC Bake & Craft Sale

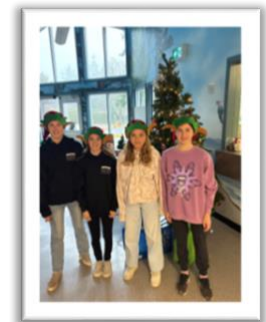
The PAC is looking for **baked goods and crafts for the Dec 16th** sale at EB!

## Parking Lot

Thank you for being conscientious about your parking. We recognize that getting to school in the morning can be a stressful time. However, we want all of our staff & students to arrive safely. ## Field Trips

Many teachers are planning field trips & have asked that we send out some reminders. School expectations apply to all field trips. Parents and Chaperones, here's how you can help to streamline the process:

- Send your child with a booster seat. The law requires children to be 90 pounds, 145 cm, or 9 years old before travelling without a booster.
- Drivers must be arranged in advance of a field trip. If there are emergencies, alternate drivers must sign an additional form.
- Chaperones we need your help to supervise children while in the community, which includes watching for safety and respectful behaviour.
